Michael Leydon suffered rigging failure leaving the first day lead to fellow New Zealander Andrew May. Peter Thompson and Peter Russell then stepped up and shared wins to seal the championship.

The handicap series was again won by Ron Bugg with a series of fifth places confirming his improvement. Mick Lemon who always grabs a handicap trophy was second with Peter Warren third in his first Nationals.
