- The membership year for regular members runs from 1st October to 30th September.
- From 1st April to 31st August fees marked with an asterisk are discounted by 50%.
- If you register in September you pay the full amount but loosely speaking get 13 months.
- Age calculation is at the start of the membership year, 1st October.
- Training fees are **once-only** and cover unlimited sail-training courses conducted by the club.
- The lower Junior/Student fee for boat storage applies if it is a strictly junior class, eg Minnow, or it is normally sailed by a student/junior member of your family.
- Boat storage position is at the discretion of the Commodore and may change.
- Winter fees are on page 2.

Payment

The on-line registration form creates an invoice which can be paid immediately with a **“Debit/Credit Card”** or downloaded and paid later by **“Bank deposit”** or **“Credit card (on paper)”** which means EFTPOS at the club or by sending card details to **membership** by email or post to the PO box. We also accept cash and cheques. Note that the **“Debit/Credit Card”** option has a surcharge of 2%+\$2 and does not accept part-payment.

New Member Details

Whether sailing or not all new members are registered with Australian Sailing (AS) using the revolutionise (aka RevSports) online system. If you have been registered with AS before then you will have an AS Number so can register as a **“RETURNING MEMBER”** and provide only your **AS Number**, your **Last name**, and your **Date of birth**.

Otherwise the following are required:

- First name
- Last name (may include spaces and apostrophes ‘ ’)
- Date of birth (absolutely essential – we do keep this private)
- Gender (Male, Female, Non-Binary, Differently identify)
- Postcode
- Mobile phone number (can be that of a parent)
- Email address (can be that of a parent or Family Head)

Optional information:

- Street address and suburb
- Home phone
- Emergency contact’s name and phone number
- Relevant medical information

How to Register a Family:

- One person, type **Senior Family Head**, pays all the fees. Register that person first adding on all required key, locker, boat storage and training.
- Open the Membership Details email you receive and click the links to register, in turn, the other family members:
 - up to one other (non-student) adult as **Senior in Family** – zero fee;

- each **Student in Family** or **Junior in Family** – also zero fee.

After registration we link family members to the head member and normally suppress near-duplicate emails.

After Registration

Membership Details Email:

If you did not have an AS Number, this email will tell you what it is and tell you your loginID with a link to establish a password. If you did have an AS Number it will tell you it but assume you know your loginID and password. If you have forgotten these then try to login to APYC via <https://revolutionise.com.au/apyc/> and there is a mechanism to discover your login and set a new password. In either case check and correct your personal details.

Tell us about your Boats:

Joining the club automatically enters you into our races and we need to manage boat storage. So after you receive your login details please either **log in and edit** the field Boat List, or **send an email to membership** with the following for each relevant boat (please use underscores instead of spaces in Boat_name and Hull_colour):

Class Sail_no. Boat_name Hull_colour **Storage** (or nothing) [semicolon]

Committee Approval

Currently our constitution requires this for new regular members (Family, Senior, Student, Junior). This will occur after registration at the next Committee meeting (11 times a year). In the highly unlikely event that your registration is not approved all fees will be refunded promptly.

Renewal

We will send invoices to paid-up (financial members). This will take place soon after October 1st when the on-line database is “rolled over”. If your membership has lapsed (unfinancial) you can register to rejoin.

Notes:

- Winter membership runs from 1st May to 30th September.
- Registration for winter opens in late March.
- You must be current members of another sailing/yacht club..
- Training is not available.
- The lower Junior/Student fee for Family boat storage applies if it is a strictly junior class, eg Minnow, or it is normally sailed by a student/junior member of your family.

How to Register a Winter Family:

- One person, type **Winter Family Head**, pays all the fees. Register that person first.
- Register each other person as **Winter Family Member** – zero fee.
