Check list of requirements of the Classic Vehicle Scheme (CVS)



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When providing access to Conditional registration under the Classic Vehicle Scheme NSWHMA relies on Clubs to know their members and their vehicles. Clubs must require owners to notify them of modifications made to their vehicles. When Clubs stamp the 1835 declaration for registration or renewal of a vehicle under the CVS they must ensure that these requirements are met and all the appropriate documents are supplied to NSWHMA including a copy of the **most recent registration certificate**.

This form is required (<u>from 1/1/2023</u>) for both initial and renewing registration. Please print out and complete, including owners details and signature. The registrar then must sign and stamp the form and send it to NSWHMA with the other paperwork.
