NOTICE OF RACE

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the SI means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification. This changes RRS 64.1.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Races will count to the various club's series results as specified internally by each club.
- **1.3** Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open free of charge to all boats from the designated Long Beach Clubs and Invited Clubs. Boats from other clubs may also compete subject to payment of a Visitor entry fee. See Item 3 below.
- All participating sailors shall be current financial members of at least one of the designated Long Beach Clubs or Invited Clubs and shall also be members of Australian Sailing.
- **2.3** Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form at https://pocketevents.app/?LHDmYyhG by 10:00 hrs on Sunday 21st March 2021.

3 FEES

- 2 4 races are scheduled for the regatta to be sailed back to back. It is the responsibility for each participating club to specify how many races will count to their individual series results. Separate arrangements will be made for trailables in the Sailing Instructions if necessary. Please note Beaumaris Yacht Club (BYC) does not have a boat ramp and all boats are launched from the beach.
- **4.3** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 12:57 hrs.
- 4.4 No warning signal will be made after 17:00 hrs on Sunday 21st March 2021.

5 **MEASUREMENTS**

The race committee reserves the right to measure any boat at any time during the series.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available after 17:00 hrs on Friday 12th March 2021 on the BYC website: www.beaumarisyc.com

7 VENUE

Attachment A shows the location of the BYC and the Racing Area. Attachment B shows the entry and exit from the BYC lagoon.

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

For all multi-hull classes, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10 SCORING

- 2 4 races are scheduled for the regatta to be sailed back to back, of which 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.2 There will be no drops. All races will count to the Long Beach Regatta.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

1st in each Division.

Winning Club will be awarded the Long Beach Regatta Trophy.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD \$5,000,000, preferably AUD \$10,000,000, per incident or the equivalent.

14 PARKING

- Limited public car parking is available in the car park immediately south of BYC parking tickets must be purchased to avoid a parking fine. Free car parking is available in Haydens Road and the streets off Haydens Road. It is a short walk back to the yacht club.
- Boat trailers will be stored on the stretch of beach immediately off the public carpark in front of BYC. On arrival, BYC marshals will direct you to remove your boat /

trailer immediately and then park your car immediately thereafter to allow further competitors to do the same.

15 SOCIAL AND PRESENTATION

- Lunch including salad rolls, scrolls, chocolate bars and drinks can be purchased at the BYC canteen. On arrival, please order and pay for your lunch so that the BYC volunteers can pre make your order while registering / rigging. Cash and credit / debit card payment will be accepted.
- After racing, drinks at bar prices with nibbles will be available at the canteen. A sausage sizzle will also be available. Cash and credit / debit card payment will be accepted. Presentation of trophies will be awarded during this time. All sailors are encouraged to attend.


