**Duty Officer**

- Please refer to the separate Duty Officer Instructions document

**Rescue Boat Swimmer / Crew**

- On arrival at the Club, please make contact with the Rescue Boat skipper or the Duty Officer who will direct you towards the RB skipper. The RB skipper will inform you of your duties for the day
- Assist where needed to prepare and load the boat(s) prior to launch
- The RBs will leave the beach at 1pm, please ensure you have had lunch and are changed and ready when the boats are to be launched
- Duties during the racing session include but are not limited to laying and retrieving course marks, performing starting tasks, assisting boats and sailors in distress if required
- Upon return to shore assist the RB skipper with tasks such as unloading and washing the boat etc. Please do not leave the RB skipper to unload and clean the boat on their own
- Come prepared to get into the water, you WILL get wet. Bring your normal sailing gear as you may be required to enter the water to assist sailors

**Canteen Officer**

- Susan Sharp will send an email to you with the relevant shopping list (as the quantity of rolls varies with the weather forecast) and Canteen duties on the Friday before your duty.

**Canteen Assistant**

- Assist the Canteen Officer with the operation of the BYC canteen
