## Junior Country Championships (JCC): 14 and 15 May 2022

This is a great competition that enables players within each association to team together against other country teams across the state. Teams normally playing 6 games over the weekend, culminating in a final.

Each association enters both boys' and girls' teams in the Junior Country Championships in Under 13, Under 15 and Under 18 competitions.

JCC is held in Melbourne at a different venue for each age group.

## Junior State Championships (JSC): 30 June 2022 – 3 July 2022

The Junior State Championships will return to Melbourne for 2022 at venues yet to be determined.

North West Lightning enter a boys and girls team in each age group – Under 13, Under 15 and Under 18. Players must be affiliated with Hockey Central Vic, North Central Hockey Association, Sunraysia Hockey Association or Wimmera Hockey Association to nominate and trial for the teams.

Trials will be held on Sunday 3rd April in Bendigo.

The teams train for 10 hours leading up to the event and the training dates are:

- Sunday 22 May
- Sunday 6 June
- Sunday 20 June
- Wednesday 29 June

U18 teams: Players will be playing in the Senior Country Championships (SCC) held in Melbourne from 11 - 13 June in lieu of training on 20 June. The Under 18 teams will stay together for the tournament with fundraising prior to the event to keep costs to a minimum.

Expected player cost is \$50 - \$70 covering team entry, first aid, training etc. Billing will only occur once final teams are entered.

Registration close for SCC on Friday 26th March for players. Coach EOI close Friday 26th March.

Coach appointments to be made following JCC & SCC subcommittee meeting on Monday 28th March at 6pm. Coaches will receive a small gratuity payment for their assistance through the trainings and tournament.

Bendigo Senjuns take supporting our coaches seriously! We ask that all coaches in 2022 undertake the [Community Coaching General Principles \(CCGP\) course](#) (at a minimum) by May 2022. The Community Coaching General Principles (CCGP) course has been developed to assist coaches to learn the basic skills of coaching, particularly those coaches working with children. The course contains four modules, covering a range of general coaching topics including; the role and responsibilities expected of a coach, planning, safety, working with parents, communication, group management and inclusive coaching practices.

If you are a coach and have already completed this, please send me your certificate. If you have not yet completed this (or any higher coaching courses), please do so ASAP.

## TEAM MANAGER NEEDED!

We are still looking for Manager for the Senior Mens team. If you are keen to nominate, please email the club.

Role of the Team Manager:

- Assists the coach and is responsible for the smooth running of the team
- Completes the teams match sheet, record goals scored and any disciplinary action taken by officials throughout the game and ensure umpires sign the match card at the conclusion of the game.
- Ensure results and team sheets are posted on RevSport.
- Reports any Breaches of the HCV Code of Conduct, either by Bendigo Senjuns members or opposition teams, to the President and/or Secretary of Bendigo Senjuns Hockey Club.
- Is aware of the guidelines regarding preference for eligibility for game selection.
- Holds confidential information about the emergency contacts for players.

## HC MELBOURNE HOLIDAY CAMP – TERM 1 2022

From Monday 11 April to Thursday 14 April 2022, HC Melbourne will be running a Holiday Camp in conjunction with Hockey Victoria will be running holiday camps for junior participants. There will be two different streams that cater for all participants.

- **PARTICIPATION STREAM** - This is aimed at younger participants (aged 6 - 10 years) who just want to get out on the pitch. Children will learn and develop their skills while participating in lots of different fun activities and games.
- **SKILL STREAM** - This is aimed at older participants (aged 11 - 16 years) who want to get out on the pitch but develop their skills. This will have a larger technical focus and with activities taken from the Hockey Victoria Academy & Elite Skill Development Day program.

By registering, participants will automatically go in a raffle to win one of the following 3 prizes:

- Hockey Stick & Stick Bag (valued at \$400)

The camps will run across four different locations, all from 9:00am – 4:00pm:

- Footscray Hockey Club – Tuesday 12 and Wednesday 13 April 2022

Junior: U10	\$66 (includes games, training and umpires fees)
Junior: U12	\$85 (includes games, training and umpires fees)
Junior: U14 / U16	\$180 (includes games, training and umpires fees)
Junior (playing both Junior and Senior games)	Junior fee (\$180) + \$15 per Senior game to a maximum of \$240 (includes games, training and umpires fees)
Masters	Women: \$10 per game (half field). Men: \$15 per game (full field) (includes games, training and umpires fees)
Students (18yrs+)	\$240 (includes games, training and umpires fees)
Club Coaches (full commitment – training and game days)	NIL FEES If sharing, half price fees given to both coaches
Casual Senior	\$30 per game (to a maximum of \$370/\$240 for 18+ student) (includes games, training and umpires fees)

	Please note: Any player playing more than 9 matches (half the regular season) should be considered a full member and pay full season fees therefore is not be eligible to pay casual rates.
Casual Junior	\$15 per game (to a maximum of \$180) (includes games, training and umpires fees)

We ask that all fees to be paid by 31 July 2022. Players must be a full financial member of the club to be eligible for finals. Bank details: BSB: 633-000, Account number: 101476687, Ref: use the club member's name.

Family discounts will be available in 2021. Please speak or email Bridget Green (Treasurer) for information.

Should any Bendigo Senjuns Hockey club members have any problems paying fees, please speak to Bridget and she can arrange a payment plan to help you out - we would prefer to have all our members playing hockey rather than sitting on the sidelines. This plan needs to be put into place prior to the first game played.

Should fees be outstanding at any point of the season without a payment plan approved by the Bendigo Senjuns Hockey Club Treasurer, that member will be ineligible to take any further part in training or games until it has been rectified.
