CHILD SAFE STANDARDS

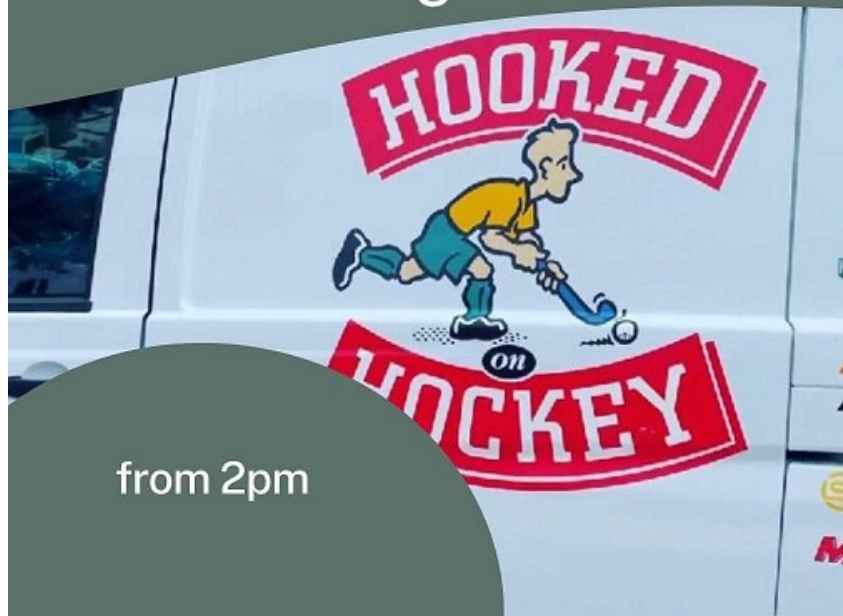
The [Child Safe Standards](#) are minimum compulsory standards for all organisations that interact with children and young people. The Standards aim to prevent abuse through a focus on cultural change and help to protect children from the risks of abuse.

New Child Safe Standards are now in place to better protect children and young people from abuse. The new Standards **commenced on 1 July 2022**. The eleven new Standards will replace Victoria's current seven standards and principles.

The Bendigo Senjuns Hockey Club Committee of Management have started discussing the new Standards in their meetings. Committee members will be asked to familiarise themselves with the resources. There may be some key tasks and events happening in 2023 to ensure we keep up to standard.
