

#### CRITERIA

The Boccia NSW Sport Development Fund offers \$2,000 to Boccia NSW members, to support the development and growth of Boccia NSW qualified coaches and referees.

#### ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for funding under this program individuals must meet the following criteria:

- be a current Boccia NSW member (membership is currently free)
- have a philosophy that aims to assist Boccia NSW/Boccia NSW clubs and athletes in either a coaching or refereeing capacity

#### APPLYING FOR SPORT DEVELOPMENT FUNDING

How to apply:

1. Complete application form attached.
2. Complete the Boccia Australia referee or coaching course prior to 20 December 2022.

How much funding can you receive for your activity?

- The maximum grant available is \$100 per BA recognised coaching/referee course.
- There is no limit to the number of applications you may submit (e.g. you may submit applications for funding to undertake your coaching qualification AND the referee qualifications), however you should specify your order of priority for funding in the application in the event the funding is oversubscribed.

#### IMPORTANT DATES:

- **Applications open 1 September 2022**
- **Applications close COB 1 October 2022**
- If funding is approved, acquittal documentation being the honorarium reimbursement form must be submitted by 1 December (whichever is sooner).
- Applicants must have completed all elements of the qualification (coaching or referees' course) **by COB 1 December 2022**.
- Failure to do so may result in any unpaid money being forfeited.

Please note that late applications may be accepted providing there is sufficient funds remaining, priority will be given to those received before the closing date for each round.

#### HOW IS OUR APPLICATION ASSESSED?

All applicants will be notified in writing about the outcome of their application, to be eligible for consideration you must meet all the criteria. Boccia NSW reserves the right to determine priorities for the allocation of funding, taking account of; the quality of the information provided, the total funds available in the program and the proactive nature of the participation to complete their boccia accreditation course.

Boccia NSW reserves the right to review final allocations of funding following receipt of final documentation where the information supplied differs greatly to the original application or where the terms and conditions of funding have not been met.

#### **WHAT IS REQUIRED ONCE FUNDING HAS BEEN APPROVED?**

Applicants must ensure that all sections of the application are completed. BNSW will contact you if further information is required to assess your application. If your application for funding is approved, you are eligible to receive up to 100% of the approved amount after the date of the activity, upon the receipt of:

- Completed honorarium form submitted to Boccia NSW by COB 1 December 2022
- completed qualification course certificate (for a recognised BA Coaching or Referee qualification)

#### Other Grants

- As part of our ongoing commitment to increasing the standard of excellence in the sport, Boccia NSW provides \$3,000 in funding for BNSW clubs towards the cost of delivery come and try style events under the BNSW Sport Development Funding Program – Club. More information can be found [HERE](#)
