CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY

Purpose:

To ensure that everybody behaves appropriately at BNSW activities, gives respect to each other and presents themselves in a professional way at all times.

Policy Procedures

All involved in boccia will:

1. Show respect and courtesy for all involved in the sport.
2. Treat everybody equally.
3. Act within the rules and spirit of our sport.
4. Act in a way which is fair and non-discriminatory.
5. Always use the appropriate complaint and grievance procedures relevant to the issue.
6. Prioritise the safety and well-being of others, particularly young athletes.
7. Encourage and support opportunities for participation.
8. Adhere to all Boccia Australia policy and procedures in relation to behaviour.
9. Not attend a boccia function while knowingly sick with a transmissible disease.

Any complaints about this policy should be made in writing to the Committee and will be considered at the next possible Committee meeting.
