Conditions of Boat Storage – 2022/2023

Please retain a copy for your reference

- 1. All yachts are stored at owner's risk and the club will not be held liable for loss or damage. Each vessel will need a certificate of current insurance or receipt of boat policy details with a minimum public liability of \$10 million.
- 2. Storage space will only be allocated to financial members. If subscriptions are not paid by Opening Day, spaces will be reallocated. **REGISTRATION STICKERS MUST BE DISPLAYED** on all boats stored.
- 3. Applications and renewals are considered in order of payment of subscriptions.
- 4. The storage is rented by the yacht owners and **IS NOT TRANSFERABLE** upon the sale of the yacht.
- 5. All **BOARDS**, **HULLS**, **AND JINKERS MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED (BOAT NAME & NO.)**. It is essential for owners to mark spars, rudders, and centreboards.
- 6. All boats are to be stored on or with jinkers in the allotted rack space. Only boats and rigging to be stored in this space.
- 7. Sailboards, equipment, cradles and jinkers left in areas other than their allocated space may be liable to confiscation and may be disposed of at the discretion of the Boat Storage Officer.
- 8. Storage space is for active members, and if the yacht is not used regularly, the space may be reallocated without refund of fees, or the yacht may not be granted storage in the following season. It is considered reasonable to expect any boat owners storing their boats shall race on a minimum of 8 club race days throughout a season. If this condition is not met the boat will not be granted storage in the following season.
- 9. Storage allocation will be posted on the main noticeboard after 1 September.
- 10. All SUPs/Windsurfers/Canoes are stored at owner's risk and the Club will not be held liable for loss or damage. Windsurfers must be stored de-rigged.
- 11. Owners of boats stored within the sheds are expected to keep their area tidy and periodically sweep out sand in their space.
- 12. Any boat owners with their boat stored in the upper level will remove the timber ramps after use and store appropriately. Be considerate of other users of the space.
- 13. To ensure all stored boats within the sheds are secure, owners of boats stored in the shed MUST ensure the sheds are secure after they have stored their boat. Storers must double check that sheds are closed before leaving the club.
