The club's Annual General meeting is scheduled to be held on Monday 11 March, starting at **7.00 pm**. # 2024 NUCOLD BUNDABERG OPEN

The entry form for the NUCOLO Bundaberg Open Championships (March 16 & 17) is now available online with copies also available at the canteen. This is

our premier tournament each year, giving our players the opportunity to test their skills against visiting players and clubmates in a wide range of graded and age events. In particular, for any players going to the Queensland Championships during the Easter school holidays, the Bundy Open will be a great chance to get valuable match practice against non-regular opponents.

### PRE-WINTER SEASON

While the numbers of players taking part in the Pre-Winter season on both Tuesday and Wednesday nights are lower than hoped for, the competitions have generally got off to a good start. The season is scheduled to finish on April 30 for Division Three and the following night for Division 1 and 2. As usual, there will be a two week break for the Easter school holidays at the start of April.

The Winter season will then begin in the first week of May, hopefully increased numbers on both nights when players return after missing this season and new players also join. If you know anyone who may be interested in playing the Winter season, please start encouraging them to come for a hit on a Friday morning or Sunday afternoon.

### **TERM 1 JUNIOR SEASON**

Similarly, the number of players for this season is disappointing but with the increased numbers of new players attending coaching sessions, hopefully many of them will join fixtures later this term or at the start of Term 2.

The annual Junior Come & Try Night was held on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> February with a good number of new players attending, as well as current Juniors. Very pleasingly, many of the new players are now regularly coming to our Junior coaching sessions and showing a lot of promise.

## **PARA & SPECIAL OLYMPICS**

The Thursday coaching sessions are held each week from 4.30-6.00 pm. With the Special Olympics State

Games to be held in November, one of the requirements for participation is that athletes must have attended training sessions regularly. The other main requirement is that they must have attended at least two SO tournaments this year.
