However, overall their results were as expected or a little better in what turned out to be very evenly contested events in which only one or two players dominated throughout.

Congratulations to Tahia Zia and Natasha Jefferson who won the Girls Under 17 Doubles after a great fightback from 7/10 in the fourth game of the final match to win it in five. Both of the girls won medals in other doubles events while Natasha was a semi-finalist in both the Girls Under 17 and Under 19 Singles events. Anushka Mudalige won two singles medals, with Braydon Chapman in the Boys Under 17 Doubles in which they defeated the top seeds in the semis, and with Tahia in the Under 17 Mixed Doubles. Braydon also won bronze medals with Natasha in the Under 17 and Under 19 Mixed Doubles events, while Tahia also won bronze with Andrew Udal in the Under 19 Mixed.

CLUB **COACHING SESSIONS**

Club coaching will resume at the start of Term 2 for Juniors and adults. Please note there have been slight increases in the cost of Coaching Passes due to the slightly longer term. The costs are now \$65.00 for one coaching per week and \$120.00 for two sessions per week throughout Term 2. The passes should be paid for when attending your first coaching session of the term. The cost for attending coaching sessions if you don't have a pass remains at \$10.00.

More young juniors are welcome to attend on both **Monday and Tuesday afternoons** (4.30 - 6.00 pm), as well as **Friday nights** (7.00 – 9.00 pm).

However, with these increased numbers, more coaches are needed, especially on Friday nights, as a couple of coaches who have been involved over the last few years are now, unfortunately, no longer available on a regular basis. Club members or parents with a playing background are needed to assist with the younger players so that they can progress more rapidly. If interested in assisting on Friday nights, or at other times, please contact me at the club as soon as possible.

Continued thanks to **Kameron Chan** who will continue to assist for the time being on Friday nights to work with the older Juniors.

The Monday night coaching sessions for adults will resume next Monday (April 19). These run most Mondays from 7.00 – 9.00 pm, and cost \$10.00 per player. It would be great to see a lot more turn up for these sessions to give everyone as much variety as possible.

The Thursday afternoon session (4.30 – 6.00pm) for Para TT and Special Olympics players went well last term with a strong regular attendance but more players are welcome. If you know anyone with a physical or intellectual disability who may be interested in playing Table Tennis, please suggest they make enquiries about this session.
