Hi, the spring season is now under way and I enjoyed playing again after a long break, although I was very rusty. We had our October committee



meeting on Thursday 14 October and a lot was discussed. Dates were decided on or proposed for our tournaments next year and annual presentation night for 2021.

Also, a lot has been going on behind the scenes with our air conditioning project. We currently have tenders out to various electrical and air conditioning contractors to supply quotes required for our grant submission. Quotes are due back before 31 October and Phil Freeman will have our grant application submitted by 5 November.

We received the Scope of Works information back from the electrical engineer outlining in detail everything required to bring this project to fruition. Our initial estimates are that the end product will cost around \$80,000 - give or take some contingencies of course. We will be applying for a grant of \$50,000 plus GST, so we are working on securing the remaining funds required to complete the project. Our club is in a healthy financial position at the moment and we are fortunate to have several significant fund raising opportunities presenting themselves to us at the right time. More about that as the details come to hand. Assuming we are successful in the grant application which will be announced in February, we hope to have the work completed before the onset of the 2022 summer. Meanwhile, our solar whirly birds should hopefully get installed before christmas this year.

Please consider your availability for our defence of the Eric Cree Shield and get your nomination in, either on our website or at the canteen with Dave as soon as possible. We will need to co-ordinate the best way to travel hence the question about your travel preferences. The team will be selected by our grading committee once all nominations have been received.

Finally, we are still looking for a cleaner until our regular cleaner has recovered from her foot surgery. If you or anyone you know is interested, please contact Dave to discuss the details. We have budgeted \$50 per week to spend on cleaning.

CLUB COACHING SESSIONS

It has been extremely pleasing to see our juniors attending their coaching sessions in solid numbers for all available sessions since the start of this term. As a result, many of our younger players are showing a lot of improvement and, just as pleasingly, increased enthusiasm with their training and in competition.

A Weekly Coaching pass as well as the Term Pass will continue for Term 4. The Weekly Pass caters for those players who were not available for the whole term due to studies or other reasons, or are just starting to attend these sessions now.

COURT CLEANING


Each court now has a separate dry mop, wet mop and bucket.
