THIS SEASON

The Spring and Term 4 Junior seasons have started with most competitions having similar or slightly fewer players than last season, despite the very welcome addition of a number of new or returning players. Hopefully there will be fewer problems with the non-availability of players than was the case during the Winter / Term 3 season.

For the Spring season, there will be a single final in Division 1 on December 7 between the top two teams after their third round, while in both Division 2 and 3 there will be no final, the premiers being decided as "first past the post" – in other words, the team with the most points at the end of their second round.

The Term 4 Junior season is scheduled to finish on Friday 25 November with a straight final between the top two teams. The format for the lower divisions is still to be decided when the final number of players is confirmed.

MORE TOURNAMENTS

The Australian Veterans Championships have concluded in Darwin, with John and Lorraine Fourro, and Rashed Aziz in Queensland teams. Lorraine won silver as a member of the Queensland Womens Over 50 team while John won bronze with the Mens Over 60

team. Congratulations to both. Queensland won several of the team events and picked up medals in plenty of others. John, Lorraine and Rashed all had narrow losses in most of their individual events but again many Queenslanders made or won finals so it was a very successful tournament for the state.
