PEARLS FROM PETE

A lot has happened since our last newsletter. We have had a successful Bundaberg Closed Championship, had the Term 3 Junior Finals and Schools Finals, concluded our Winter Season fixtures with some great finals matches, had our September committee meeting, and facilitated a TOPS (Entry Level) Coaching Course. Congratulations to all the winners and runners up of the finals and all participants in the Bundy Closed. I look forward to seeing most of you

back for the Spring Season fixtures starting 5th and 6th October. If you haven't already nominated, please let Dave know asap, even if you can put your name down as a reserve.

At our last committee meeting, the decision was made to engage the professional services of an engineer to assist us in deciding the best way to proceed with our air conditioning project. This decision was made because of the myriad of options and suggestions that were being presented and our lack of specific knowledge in deciding the most efficient and costeffective way forward. To that end, Phil Freeman contacted Tim Muller (Electrical Engineer) from Geared Projects, and we subsequently engaged Tim's services to provide us with guidance on the best way for us to proceed. Tim has provided his initial report which we (myself, Phil and Dave) followed up with a face-to-face meeting at the Club on Friday 17th September. Tim is now preparing a project scope document outlining the specific requirements for us to approach contractors to supply quotes.

There are three main areas of work, including electrical upgrades, roof insulation and aircon system installation. Once we have this scope document, we can obtain 3 quotes for each area of work and submit our grant application before 2 November 2021. Initial estimates predict we could achieve the roof insulation, 8 split system aircon units and electrical upgrades for around \$60K, meaning the Club should contribute around \$12K and hopefully a grant for the remainder. We will keep you posted on the progress of the project.

In the meantime, we received the funding to install solar powered whirly birds in the roof, additional to our existing whirly birds. This work should be done hopefully very soon, which should provide some immediate relief for the upcoming summer.

Finally, just a quick mention regarding the livestreaming of our major events recently. I hope you have had a chance to look at some of the action. For those of you that don't have Facebook, the videos are also on our Bundaberg Table Tennis YouTube channel. It would be great if we could get a lot more subscribers on the YouTube channel. I am always open to suggestions and positive feedback on how to make things better. I am sure you can imagine how time and resource intensive it is to provide this service. That's it for this month.


FAIR PLAY VOUCHERS

Congratulations to the successful teams and players who won their respective finals of the Winter and Term 3 Junior seasons over the last week or so.


Old Boys (Steve Mitchell, Pieter Poldervaart) won Division One, downing Doubles Bs (Bernadette

Please get advice through the club first. In particular, many of the bats available in some local stores are either not legal for competition or are of poor quality.




