CLUB COACHING SESSIONS

With the start of the new term, club coaching will resume next week. However, some changes are planned, especially with the Junior sessions. These will be confirmed at next Monday's Committee meeting, but are expected to be:

Monday 4.00 – 6.00 Younger Juniors training with Steve Mitchell and Dave Delpratt

Tuesday 4.00 – 6.00 Representative Juniors training with Steve; other Juniors training with Dave (4.30 - 6.00)

Other sessions remain the same as for last term.

Coaching fees have had to be increased as explained by Peter in his column. A **Weekly Coaching pass** has been re-introduced to complement the **Term Pass** which proved very popular. The Weekly Pass will cater for those players who may not be available for the whole term due to studies or other reasons.

The above fees apply to all club members – Juniors and Adults.

Club members or parents with a playing background are needed to assist with the younger players so that they can progress more rapidly. Thanks again to **Kameron Chan** who assisted for much of this year on Friday nights to work with our Juniors. However, he will be returning to Melbourne in the next week or so, which is partly to reason for the request above. CAN YOU HELP ??

The **Thursday afternoon session (4.30 – 6.00pm) for Para TT and Special Olympics players** now has a strong regular attendance but more players are welcome. BUNDABERG SCHOOLS CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Bundaberg regional qualifying tournament for the 2021 Queensland Schools Championships will be held on **Saturday 21 August**. Information has been sent to all schools in the Bundaberg area, as well as Phys Ed teachers and other contacts at the schools. There are three age categories – 12 years and under, 15 years and under, 18 years and under.

The competition is for teams of two players (same gender) but extra players can be nominated to a team on the entry form if necessary.

Teams which win or are runners-up in their category in Bundaberg will be eligible to enter the **State Finals** which will be held in Brisbane on **Friday 17 September**. In the past, Bundaberg teams have had a great amount of success at the State Finals.

The **Queensland Schools Para Championships** will also be held on **Friday 17 September** at Brisbane in conjunction with the Schools State Finals. In this tournament, teams can have mixed genders and players do NOT have to be from the same school.

It's hoped that many of our club Juniors will organise teams at their school, either between themselves or with friends. With the club looking for more junior players, this tournament will be a great way to introduce new players to competition, so please try to get as many teams as possible from your school.
