Junior match notified	Amount equivalent to match fee for non-offending team
Junior match not notified (Forfeiting team also has to pay the turf fee for both teams)	\$60.00
<b>INELIGIBLE PLAYER</b> Playing an ineligible player or playing a suspended player or engaging a suspended coach/team official incurs a team forfeit plus fine.	\$50.00
<b>BREACHING TURF RULES</b> (eg not entering the pitch via the water trap, jumping the fence)	\$50.00
<b>Failure to attend Competition Committee meeting</b>	
1 <sup>st</sup> offence	Warning
2 <sup>nd</sup> offence ( 2 consecutive meetings)	\$50
Each subsequent offence after 2 <sup>nd</sup> offence	All Senior teams in that club will lose one premiership point for each additional breach

## 2. LOCAL RULES - SEASON 2023

By-Law 13.1 - Variations to Rules adopted by the CCHA for season 2023

No variations except as listed below.

Senior Competitions.

<b>Goalkeepers</b>	If a team chooses to not play with a goalkeeper then no player shall have goalkeeper privileges.
<b>Match Duration</b>	Women's / Wednesday night – 15 minute quarters with 2 minute quarter time and a 5 minute half time break Men's – 17 minute quarters with 2 minute quarters and a 5 minute half time break

Under 17

<b>Match duration</b>	15 minute quarters with 2 minute quarter times and a 5 minutes half time break.
<b>Player eligibility</b>	Teams may be of a mixed gender. Boys must be U17. Girls players can be U18.
<b>Goalkeeper</b>	Teams must field a fully equipped goalkeeper (defined as wearing at least head gear, leg guards and kickers).
<b>Team Numbers</b>	Teams will be 11 a side, with up to 16 players being included on the match card in line with normal FIH rules
<b>Modified rules</b>	Nil

Under 14

<b>Match duration</b>	15 minute quarters with 2 minute quarter times and a 5 minutes half time break.
<b>Player eligibility</b>	Teams may be of a mixed gender. All players must be U14
<b>Goalkeeper</b>	Teams must field a fully equipped goalkeeper (defined as wearing at least head gear, leg guards and kickers).

Under 12

<b>Match duration</b>	11 minute quarters with 2 minute quarter times and a 5 minutes half time break. Games MUST finish on time regardless of the starting time (see By-Law 20).
<b>Player eligibility</b>	Teams may be of a mixed gender. All players must be U12
<b>Goalkeeper</b>	Teams must field a fully equipped goalkeeper (defined as wearing at least head gear, leg guards and kickers).

<b>Match duration</b>	11 minute quarters with 2 minute quarter times and a 5 minutes half time break. Games MUST finish on time regardless of the starting time (see By-Law 20).
<b>Modified Rules</b>	The use of Tomahawks in this age group is not permitted

#### Under 10

<b>Field Size</b>	Games will be played on a half field
<b>Match duration</b>	11 minute quarters with 2 minute quarter times and a 5 minutes half time break.
<b>Player eligibility</b>	Teams may be of a mixed gender. All players must be U10
<b>Team Numbers</b>	Teams will be 8 a side, with up to 16 players being included on the match card in line with normal FIH rules
<b>Goalkeeper</b>	Teams must field a fully equipped goalkeeper (defined as wearing at least head gear, leg guards and kickers).
<b>Modified Rules</b>	The use of Tomahawks in this age group is not permitted
<b>FIH Rule 9.7: Playing the ball at any height</b>	Players will be restricted to playing the ball when it is below shoulder height.
<b>Coaches on the field</b>	1 Coach will be permitted onto the field during normal round games up until the 31 <sup>st</sup> July They are not permitted to enter either circle areas or stand behind the baseline From 1 <sup>st</sup> Aug the coach must remain in the designated coaching area
<b>Finals</b>	Drawn Grand Final will result in joint winners being declared

#### Under 8

<b>Field size</b>	Games will be played on quarter field
<b>Match duration</b>	15 minute halves and a 5 minutes half time break.
<b>Player eligibility</b>	Teams may be of a mixed gender. All players must be U8
<b>Team numbers</b>	Teams will be 5 a side
<b>Goalkeeper</b>	No goalkeeper is permitted in this format
<b>Coaches on the field</b>	1 Coach will be permitted onto the field during normal round games
