  - Shotgun 5-Stand, Down The Line (or D.T.L.) and Sporting Clays
  - o 50m/100m Rifle (Muzzle Loading Black Powder, Rimfire & Air Rifle ONLY)
  - o 300m Rifle (Cartridge Black Powder and Centrefire)
  - o Pistol (we are currently using the G.D.P.C range for our Pistol members)
  - NO Centrefire can be shot from the 50m / 100m range
- You MUST be a current member of S.S.A.A. NSW prior to applying for membership with our club.

  - o It is your decision if you wish to use SSAA NSW to support your "genuine reason" for having a firearms licence, OR you can use CCML direct to support your genuine reasons for Target or Hunting (club).
- As a minimum, you must have **Rec Hunting Hunting Club** OR **Rec Hunting / Vermin Control** to be able to use our club facilities and practice days.

- You must have Sport / Target Shooting as a genuine reason on your licence to be able to shoot any of our "Competition" events at our Range.

- We **do not** have Firearms to loan out you will need all your own firearms/equipment to participate in our club events.

- We do not have storage facilities to offer to members you must have safe storage / arrange safe storage of your firearms yourself.

- We do not offer "experience days" if this is what you are after, let me know and I can refer you to an organisation that offers this (for Shotgun unsure of somewhere for Rifle). This includes ANY individuals wishing to try our sport on a P650 form.
  - We are not currently using P650 forms on our range.
- It is a requirement BEFORE you apply for membership online, you need to visit our facilities have a conversation with one of our trained Range Officers.
  - If you are being referred to join from an existing member, please make sure you have their full name and
     CCML Club Membership Number, this information is required when applying.
  - o If you do not know any current members, please make this known to the Range Officer when you arrive to check out our facilities you will need to note down their Name and Membership number.
- The days you can visit to check out our facilities align with our Shoot Calendar our club is run by volunteers, so please be patient with ALL of us.

- If you join please allow up to 10 business days to receive your Membership approval text / email.

If you DO NOT currently hold a valid Firearms Licence – you will need to keep in mind the following:
General steps for New Members who are Applying for their Firearms licence:

- 1. Visit the Club facilities to make sure the club will meet your needs.
  - a) You will need the Full Name of Member Nominating you to become a member of this club (mandatory)
  - b) Membership Number of the Member Nominating you to become a member
  - c) Name of Committee Member / Range Officer personnel you completed your range visit and orientation with.
- 2. Join SSAA NSW <a href="https://membership.ssaa.org.au/new-membership/nsw">https://membership.ssaa.org.au/new-membership/nsw</a>
- 3. Join CCML
  - a) Allow up to 10 business days to receive membership confirmation, we do try and turn these around quicky, but as mentioned our club is run by volunteers, so please be patient.
- 4. Complete your Safety Training (let me know if you require local contacts)
- 5. Apply for a Firearms licence this is done through your Service NSW Account
- 6. Receive your Firearms licence (can take 2-6 months, sometimes quicker depending)
- 7. Install a safe (get an inspection from the Local Police)
- 8. Decide on the type of Firearm you would like to purchase
- 9. Lodge a Permit to Acquire (PTA) this is done through your Service NSW Account
- **10.** Receive the PTA and finalise your Firearm Purchase either at a Gun Shop, or through a Licenced Firearms Dealer.
- **11.** Come to the range to participate in club events.
