

Cumberland Nepean Softball Association Trainee Coach - Representative Team

The Trainee Coach is role to encourage new representative coaches to participate and learn the fundamentals of representative coaching. They are responsible for supporting and ensuring that all aspects of the Teeball/Softball respective representative team are managed for the applicable age group under direction of the CNSA Head Coach and Assistant Coaches.

Responsibilities

- Support the CNSA Head Coach as part of the representative softball program e.g., follow instructions, guidance etc.
- Ensure that all equipment and relevant training materials are available during training and ensure the supervision of all players at all training and game events.
- Assist with player welfare and training e.g., run training drills, assist with writing up of line ups, and team management, assisting where required or instructed by the Head or Assistant Coach
- Attend all relevant events as outlines by the Head Coach e.g., Gala Days, Training days and State championships
- Work with the Team Manager to assist with the management of the team.
- · Complete training as required by CNSA, Softball NSW and Softball Australia
- Work with the CNSA Representative Liaison Officer/s
- Attend parent / player meetings as required
- Other ad hoc requirements as required for the position and as set by CNSA

Selection Criteria

- Completed the Foundation Coaching Accreditation from Softball Australia
- Has coached at club level for at least one year. NOTE: If you are applying for a junior team, it is
 preferred that you need to have coached that age group previously.
- Available all State Championship commitments
- Demonstrated effective coaching techniques and skills for the game of Teeball / Softball
- Demonstrated knowledge of Softball rules, regulations and other specific techniques of the sport
- Demonstrated strong working relationships with others such as support staff, managers, umpires
