
Thank you to Jono Tong for his commitment to coach the NT Junior squad on Saturday mornings and throughout the week.


John Pudney for the use of his trailer and time to join me and Michael Yaxley last year in external events promoting our club and table tennis to the wider community.




The number of young players playing in all 3 grades is heartening, the future of our club is in the development of our junior players, and providing a place for beginners to learn to play table tennis, with a pathway to develop the juniors playing skills and techniques to reach their full potential. It is especially heartening to see Monday Juniors progress to C grade and beyond.

The 2023 NT Junior Squad, comprising Martin Feng, Sebastian Lai, Renee Li and newcomer Antara Panchal, trained with coach Jonathan Tong. Martin, Sebastian and Renee competed in the Junior events at the National Championships in Sydney in July with some good results. All four of these top juniors competed with the club's top players in A grade in 2023 and this year.

Importantly, the older members of our club can still be social and active to join the weekly Tuesday and Thursday morning seniors program, with many of them also playing in C grade. I would like to thank Geni O'Brien and Ann Webb who have assisted Christine Marshall running the very successful seniors program. Last year, more seniors than ever joined our club to come along and play social table tennis. Many new Seniors joined us as a result of our popular Seniors Month program in August.

2023 and this year have been a continuation of strengthening and expanding table tennis in the Darwin / Palmerston area to more people in our community and providing a family friendly environment for all races, cultures, and like-minded people that love to play table tennis.





For the first time the club ran what we called *Sunday Social* sessions in 2023 aimed at attracting the general public to come and try out table tennis on a casual basis. We look forward to continuing these sessions in 2024 starting on 28 April. Please come and help if you can spare a Sunday now and again.

The TY Lee Perpetual Trophy has been donated to the club by the Lee family in recognition of TY's lifelong commitment to table tennis in the NT and notably at the Darwin club, and particularly for his work with the juniors. TY was a champion player, and a dedicated and expert coach, guiding the development of many of our leading junior players. We are delighted to accept this wonderful trophy which will be awarded for the first time in 2024.

The club has healthy financials, with many thanks to Ann Webb for keeping on top of both incoming and outgoing money. Overall we were slightly cash positive in the 2023 year. It costs the club approximately \$35000 per year for rent/power/cleaning/coaching and equipment expenses. It is my focus to keep the costs to members as low as possible, while making enough revenue to cover our expenses. Ann will expand a little more on this aspect of the club.
