Semi-finals 1: Sweet Chilli v Benfica

The grade's top side, *Sweet Chilli*, had all the answers in their semi-final clash with *Benfica* to propel themselves into the grand final with a near dominant display on Wednesday night.

The contest ended at the doubles stage, as **Pedro Lay** and **Jeremie Langlois** held off a determined **Shino Joy** and **Elfrida Kalich**, 11-3, 14-12, 10-12, 11-7.

Earlier in the tie, Pedro ensured his team would have the 2-0 advantage coming into the doubles when he produced one of the match wins of the season to oust A Grade individual winner Elfrida, 9-11, 12-10, 3-11, 11-7, 9-11, 11-8, 11-7.

Semi-finals 2: TL&TSOI v Roadies

Meanwhile, in the second semi-final, *Roadies* recovered after dropping the first rubber to defeat *The Long & the Short of It.*

Mohit Banjade closed out the tie when he crushed **Dae Gerschwitz** in the fourth rubber which secured his team's place in the grand finale, 11-2, 12-10, 11-3, 11-4.

Earlier, **Mitchell Bedford** got his team off to the best possible start when he defeated Mohit in the opener, 4-1. However, it all unravelled for the youngest team in the semifinals when they fell to the lefty combination of Mohit and **John Pudney** in the doubles, 11-6, 11-8, 12-10.

Sweet Chilli v Roadies

We are only one match away from crowning the latest winners of the A Grade team trophy. It will be an interesting contest between two of the better teams in the competition.

On one side, we have the top team, *Sweet Chilli*, who initially had a slow start to the season before finishing strongly, especially in the semi-finals, when they did not give their opposition a chance to weave themselves back into the contest. **Pedro Lay** is looking to steer his team home, especially with **Dennis Evans'** replacement **Jeremie Langlois**.

On the opposing side are the *Roadies*, who have cruised into the grand final with a lot of confidence on the back of strong performances in the doubles recently and their impressive semi win over *The Long & the Short of It*. Captain **John Pudney** will expect to continue with their run and form to the title.

Sweet Chilli have had the wood on Roadies in all of their encounters this season, both ending 3-2. However, not much can be gained from their history since Sweet Chilli's Dennis was present in both contests and will not be in the final.

Therefore, there are two key rubbers to watch for in the final. Pedro and John will face off in a do-or-die singles contest, their head-to-head squared at one win apiece this season. The winner will most likely determine which team ends as the victors, while the doubles will also be a key factor, slightly favouring the *Roadies*.

Semi-finals 1: MNM v Runners

Earlier, **Mohit Banjade** (*MNM*) managed to single-handedly keep his team in the contest when he won both singles, including the rubber of the night against **Ryan Starkey**, 11-0, 12-14, 11-13, 11-3, 7-11, 11-6, 13-11. Ultimately, it proved to be in vain.

In the other match, *Raptors* enjoyed a comfortable victory over the *Bush Turkeys* to qualify for the final.

Viqar Ali Khan and Andrew Barton were at their best, clinching the doubles rubber in straight sets and with that wrapping up the tie.

Earlier, Andrew held his nerve to overcome a late comeback by the competitive **Rick Gibson** in the second rubber, 5-11, 11-5, 11-8, 11-9, 5-

11, 8-11, 11-6. Andrew's pace and accuracy in the final set got him over the line, which he carried into the doubles.

With the team trophy on the line in the B Grade grand finale, both teams will be looking to gain the ascendancy and eventually pull off the victory on the night.
