Report

A Grade

R&R clinched a narrow win over the competitive Monsoon to stay within the top four on Wednesday night. Fresh from her successful run at the Hopes Week, Renee Li started sluggish but eventually won a crucial encounter against Eugene Laoc, 5-11, 5-11, 11-7, 11-8, 11-8. In another contest, Celebrity Apprentice outmuscled #Swag to obtain their sixth match win. The rubber of the round was between Martin Feng and Sebastian Lai, with the latter coming back from 2-1 games down to defeat his older rival, 4-11, 11-9, 8-11, 14-12, 11-9. Roadies got over the line over Salty Plums, thanks to Ramez Mikhail's singles wins, especially a four-set victory over **Pham Luan**. The doubles were the deciding factor in this clash, with Ramez teaming up with Jui Kai Lark, winning 7-11, 9-11, 11-7, 14-12, 15-13. Whatever maintained their top spot on the ladder, thanks to a one-sided victory over the Contractors. Anhtai Lee (Contractors) won the only rubber for his side over **Dennis Evans**, 9-11, 11-8, 11-7, 1-11, 11-3. Lastly, Snappers held off Excelsior to keep themselves within the mix of a top four berth. **TT Lee** was too good in the singles, where he claimed a crucial win against **Pedro Lay**, 8-11, 11-7, 8-11, 11-8, 11-5.

B Grade

Los de Adentro won a tight 3-2 victory over Jumanji to widen the gap between the top four teams and the rest on Earth Day. The doubles proved decisive for Mo Zhong's team, claiming an emphatic straight game win. Shino Joy (Jumanji) did all he could in the lost cause, winning both his singles, including an impressive 3-0 win over an in-form Mo. Power Play outclassed Wildcard to remain second on the ladder in a top-four clash. Aaron Dunn showed signs of his vintage form, winning both singles, while his doubles win with Michael Ndukwe was a confidence booster. In another match, Bluefire held off K.T. in a tough contest. Kelvin On (K.T.) made sure it was close when he won both singles, including an enthralling victory over Ryan Starkey, 4-11, 11-7, 11-7, 9-11, 11-8.

C Grade

Buffaloes maintained their buffer in the top four, thanks to a commanding victory over Yasakas. Luca Lobo and Rammani Phuyal both won three singles to get their team a much-needed percentage boost. In one of the few highlights for the losing team, Timon Sturm pulled off an exciting win over **Tyler Tran**, 11-5, 9-11, 11-7, 1-11, 11-7. In another match, Darwin Sixers blew away fellow top-four, Dolphins, in an 8-3 romp. Mark Myerscough led the way with three singles wins, shutting down previous top C Grader Graeme Perkins in the process, 3-0. Finally, to no one's surprise, CFX3 finished the night as overwhelming winners with this round's victim: Fair Play. Willem Kaijser (Fair Play) prevented the whitewash with an impressive straight game victory over an in-form Michael Calwell.

NT Open 2021 Report (10-4-21)

Oscar van Cuylenborg is the 2021 NT Open Champion defeating a previous open champion Jonathan Tong in a hard-fought battle, 4 games to 1. Oscar proved too consistent for Jonathan, winning a greater percentage of fast hitting loop drives. Both players fought aggressively right through to the last point in very challenging humid conditions. The Semi-finals provided some close games for both finalists where Jonathan Tong defeated Elfrida Kalich 4 games to 1 after conceded the first game. Similarly, Oscar van Cuylenborg conceded his first game to Pham Luan but then proved too consistent for his rival.

Oscar Cuylenborg joined forces with Jonathan Tong to take out the **Open Doubles** defeating Pham Luan and Pedro Lay, 3 games to 0, having had a relatively predictable smooth run through the preliminary games.

B grader Aaron Dunn defeated A grader Pedro Lay
- 3 games to 1 to take out the **Restricted and Handicapped Event**. A Grader Pedro had a difficult
task ahead of him after conceding 6 points each
game as his calculated handicap. All restricted
games were extremely close and unpredictable
making for some interesting battles.

Martin Feng has become the NT Open Junior U/17 Champion after a gruelling round robin challenge with 4 other top Juniors. Runner Up was Sebastian Lai with Renee Li coming in a close third.

Sebastian Lai combined with Martin Feng to take out the **Junior Doubles** against Amy Zhao and Jordan Lai. Jordan and Amy were able to take one very convincing game but succumbed to a the much stronger no. 1 seeds.

Elfrida Kalich won the **Veteran's title** after narrowly defeated Pham Luan, 3 games to 2.
