General Business:

Kitchen – investigating an arrangement with Aurelia's Café to run the canteen this season. Teams will still be available to hold fundraising activities out of the canteen. Aurelia's will take over the ordering storage, provision and sale of food and drinks from the canteen from 8AM until 6PM on Saturdays. A formal proposal is to be bought to the March meeting. As a result juniors and women's teams do not have to provide volunteers to do canteen duty, the possibility of women's teams being rostered onto the bar was discussed. Further discussion on this, social coordinator role and the cleaning of the toilets carried over to the March meeting.

The kitchen is currently still undergoing an upgrade and is unable to be used until certified by the Shire. Requires compliant flooring, lighting, cornices, exhaust, hand basin and grease trap. The approximate cost is \$10 000, largely dependent on the cost of the rangehood.

The option of including doors on the cupboards was discussed – Heath McDonald to get quotes for this.

• Women's teams will trial a sister team system to increase the social side of hockey and support the development of increased skills across the teams. Teams determine for themselves how much they are involved with each other,

the initial focus will be an invitation to train together. Sister teams are Emus – Strikers, Condy – Bacchus, Mallee – Legs (changed later in the week to Condy – Legs, Mallee – Bacchus). This is an informal arrangement.

- Cascade Cup will not run this year Fraser O'Brien
- Men's preseason training to be held on Friday nights. Rachel Hoey is also running preseason training for anyone interested on Thursdays from 6- 7PM. Men's and women's captains to circulate this information.
- Hopetoun are running a women's carnival 27 March. Women's captain to gauge interest in putting in a team.
- Registrar Angela Hill
 New registration system for 2020. It is a registration system and website fixtures, ladders, goalscorers.

 Sub-committee formed to facilitate adoption of new system Registrar, Secretary, Junior Coordinator, Treasurer.
 Discussion on fees for 2020 all increase by \$10, with the exception of the casual player fee which will remain \$10 a week.
