- The club facilitated the 2022 Holiday Program as this was not offered by the lift company under the Winter Sports Programs. The revenue of \$50,549 also includes the week 3 'Holiday Program' that was run last year and the Friday coaching for the part time seasonal participants. This is the largest revenue and expense item in the profit and loss. Costs for these programs totalled \$45,846.
- Overall the club made a net profit of \$626
- The bank position for the club improved in 2022 increasing to \$203,252.
