

## PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT



As a player selected to play representative Hockey for Goulburn District Hockey Association for the current season you must meet the following requirements with regard to your conduct:

- Behave in a sporting manner with respect to all other players, coaching staff, officials and spectators.
- Do not argue or show disrespect to any other player, members of coaching staff, officials or spectators.
- Play the whistle, regardless if you disagree with a decision made.
- Do not engage in any inappropriate and or physical contact with players and or officials during play.
- Accept responsibility for all actions taken. Exercise reasonable care to prevent injury by ensuring that you play within the rules. Reasonable care consists of showing due diligence in abiding by the rules and adhering to the official's decisions.
- You must not take part in any social activities whilst away representing Goulburn District Hockey Association that is not approved by your manager.
- Alcohol and Smoking in uniform is prohibited and illicit drugs are strictly prohibited.
- You must act honestly, in good faith and in the best interest or your own safety, your team and Goulburn District Hockey Association.
- Be responsible and aware that along with your association you are representing your family and home town.
- Do not make any public comments which would be construed as derogatory against, or critical of my team and home association.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Refrain from using obscene, offensive or insulting language and/or making obscene gestures which may insult other players, officials or spectators.

A breach of these terms and conditions will result in you being prohibited from further participation in the Goulburn District Hockey Association competition in which you have registered.
