

## **DUTY OFFICER – DUTIES LIST**

- 1. Log into the FindMyShift system and register for Duty Officer roster well in advance of the day you plan to be the Duty Officer.
- 2. The observer role in the control tower may need to be filled by you as Duty Officer.
- 3. In the week prior to allocated DO roster date, log into the FindMyShift system and confirm that members have volunteered for the skipper and crew of the rescue boat ML11.

## 4. On race day:

- Arrive at the Club early.
- Pick up and wear the Duty Officer vest from the Control Tower.
- Check defibrillator is in place and operation light is blinking.
- Open all gates ready for the day.
- Help to put out and retrieve the mats.
- Raise and lower the Merricks flag.
- Be ready to welcome any visitors.
- Take the role of Control Tower observer if necessary.
- Lock up at the end of the day either personally or by delegation.
- Help to inflate the course marks.
- 4. If unavailable for duty, please arrange an alternative from your fellow sailors as your stand in.
- 5. Your average points for the series will be awarded if you can't sail and you do have to man the tower e.g. average points for the summer series.
