#### Item #5. Scoreboards (raised by Michelle Clark)

#### **Scoreboard**

- An Aussport technician attended the Hockey Centre this afternoon with Michelle C
- Michelle and the technician did a walk around to each scoreboard and took pictures.
- The Technician tested the transmission to the ATF and Turf 3.
- The Technician believes that the scoreboards need an upgrade. He is going to start with a few different measures to try and correct the problems we are having.
  - Jason Sipek arrived and also spoke with the technican. Jason's knowledge of the scoreboard and program is exceptional.
- Jason is going to put together a list of all of the programming glitches that he can think of including the addition of a lock on settings.

#### Ausport are going to put together a proposal that includes the following:

- New transmission boxes for each scoreboard.
- New inside antennas which will help increase range.
- The program will be run on a different frequency (The same as what garage doors are run on as opposed to the 2 way radio band we are currently on). Upgrades will include the need to Aussport having access to the scoreboards internal components. This will involve the use of scaffolding on the ATF and TLF. (Only on non playing surfaces)
- If Aussport think that after the above upgrades that we still need to increase the range Antenna's will be moved to outside the viewing area on the TLF.
  - There are also a few further measures they can take.

## **TLF**

- On inspection of the TLF scoreboard the Hooter and Antenna is missing.
- Aussport won't have access now on the TLF until the turf is finished. On approval of the quote they will lock us in for as soon as the Turf is finished. If the upgrade is not complete on the TLF we can still run the TLF on the current components and the two other fields with the new components without any issue.

# Clubs entering or reentering the competition

- For the Evolution of our Association we need to look at Small Clubs coming in and out of the Senior Competition. Especially the clubs that don't have Junior teams.
  - MVHA will consider creating parameters to enter the competition If you want to do it we want your to mean it.

The following will be some of the criteria that Clubs will need to meet:

- To come into the competition Clubs will need to be on Revolutionise, have a Fully formed Board & executive and at least one Junior Side for every Senior Club. You must also have a HIN2H coach.
- If MVHA does allow clubs to come in and our of the competition they will need to source players from the pool of players which already exists which creates problems in iteslf.
  - We will get better hockey with a vertical structured competition.
  - There will need to be an amendment made to Playing rules around nominations if a change is made.

## **Summer Comp**

- The current Summer Comp has merit but are we able to look at a preseason competition.
- There is the possibility that we can get Juniors into the Senior competition by coming through straight into B Grade.
- C grade would then become an over 35's competition (or players with less than 2 years hockey experience). Players will still be graded as an interim step.
  - C Grade could possibly be played on a Tuesday night.
  - Start working with our Masters Committee's. Try and get Men's Masters and Women's Masters to have a BOM members.

## Hookin2Hockey 2024

- Look at the possibility of introducing a Non competitive Division 4 competition that is half field and has a Club Based component. 8-10 year olds.
  - It will close the gap for 8-10 year olds. The current age group of 6-11 is too wide.
- Players to still have 20 min of skills drills all mixed together. Players would then move to their Club coach and play half field games.
  - Benefits Coaches are more likely to show every week. Participants are more likely to show every week.
  - Participants have a direct point of contact.
  - Participants start to want more at this age.
  - This will help clubs transition players to full side teams on a Saturday.

## **Board Commitments**

- Try to reduce Board Commitments on a Weekends. Maybe we ask Clubs to supply responsible people to cover shifts.
- BOM to still do Open and Close.
- · Adam suggested that each Board members goes and invites someone to join the Board of Management.
- Tony B reiterated the importance of inviting someone to join the BOM.
- The suggestion was made to add a rule to the playing rules that Clubs would have to supply a Board Member. If aproved it would take away the P & S meeting.
  - · Go back to the Clubs and discuss

## **Meeting with Wingham**

- · Adam S and Lewy had a meeting with Wingham. It was very beneficial to have the meeting.
- Meetings with Clubs in the future could form important insights as to what is happening within clubs.
- Next year MVHA will be much tougher on Clubs fulfilling duties.
- Duty Officer more successful if Clubs are rostered around games.

#### Item #18. General business (raised by Tony Barton)

#### JMC -

- There was a question at the last JMC meeting which was raised around the Selection process of an Under 13's boys player.
- If a player is Primary registered with Manning Valley Hockey Association then they are entitled to play Representative Hockey for MVHA.
  - Gloucester players are primary registered with MVHA
- There was also a discussion about a Player that played in the Port Under 15's Rep team and plays in Division 3 locally. The player only played in the first two rounds when the competition was non competitive and hasn't played since. Regardless of the players skill the player is still eligible to play Div 3 juniors.
