

NCR Players and Parents/Guardians CODE OF CONDUCT

By registering with North Coast Raiders Hockey Club every player, parent and guardian agrees to abide at all times by the Club's Code of Conduct, including updates from time to time.

PLAYERS:

- 1. Play by the rules.
- 2. Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition.
- 3. Work equally hard for yourself and your teammates. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
- 4. Never argue with an umpire. If you disagree, have your captain, coach or manager approach the umpire during a break or after the game.
- 5. Treat all participants in hockey as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of your team mates or another competitor.
- 6. Cooperate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- 7. Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please parents and coaches.
- 8. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- 9. If carded or sent off accept the umpire's decision, leave the field immediately to the players' bench and do not throw any equipment once off the field.
- 10. Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviours.
- 11. Taking to Social Media to sledge or abuse officials, team mates, coaches or players is not acceptable.
- 12. Respect Club Equipment ensure all equipment is packed up after each training session and game.
- 13. Protection equipment rules must be adhered to at all training sessions and games.
- 14. Club attire must be worn at all games.

PARENTS and GUARDIANS:

- Do not force an unwilling child to participate in hockey.
- 2. Remember, children are involved in hockey for their enjoyment, not yours.
- 3. Encourage your child to play by the rules, in the spirit of the game of hockey and to be as good sport.
- 4. Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- 5. Never yell or ridicule a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- 6. Remember that children learn best by example. Appreciate good performances and skilful plays by all participants.
- 7. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- 8. Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- 9. Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate.
- 10. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- 11. Parents are to abide by Club's, Hockey WA and Associations Healthy Club Policies at all Junior Hockey Matches.
- 12. During games and training sessions smoking is not permitted within 100 metres of any playing or training ground.
