This whole area still becomes cluttered and dusty for those that venture in including our visiting umpires. An investment in the pitching machine 'Iron Mike' we hope will reap dividends. We will continue to closely with Salisbury Council on appropriate storage options so we can get this in use ASAP.

On to our teams on field!

Without stealing Willie's thunder, the Juniors are looking to be developing well. The new playing tops looked awesome. Entering a Pee-Wee team this season was exciting, and Kirsty did a great job with this group. Well done Kirsty firstly for putting your hand up and embracing this opportunity. It was fantastic to see a parent with very little baseball experience prepared to jump in, and I am especially proud as a club to be able to offer this experience to a female member. I had no doubt you would succeed, and I know the parents loved the work you did.

Although the Pee-Wee team did strip back T-Ball participants the combined training and the want and need to keep feeding kids in through these 2 avenues is imperative. Thanks to Trev for taking on this role again and the Parents also for assisting each week.

The Minor League U11s improved throughout the season and our super star Little League U13s had again an amazing season taking the Premiership, well done to all coaches!

A huge thanks to Chris Whittlesea for taking the Intermediate U14 combined team with Gawler. It was so important to have these kids play this year and not lose them to the club or the game. Finally, congratulations to Amara Quin on her year with the Gawler Junior League U15s and being involved in their premiership.

To the juniors Lachlan Vine and Jack Wilton congratulations on your successful Adelaide Marlins Charter team selection and good luck at the National titles.

To all our other Senior, Junior and Perpetual trophy winners' congratulations on a fine season.

Our Women's D2 team headed by Simon 'Robbo' Robertson had an up and down season. 13 players is a great number and the ladies continued to have fun each week and really bought into Robbo's program based around learning the game and bettering their baseball fundamentals. The committee would love to get 2 women's teams next year.

The potential to have home games every Friday night is a great opportunity to get people to the club, enjoying baseball and the club atmosphere.

For our Divisions 1/2/3 it was a tough year. Across the squad there were several player returns that didn't eventuate and player departures mid-season that meant we were undermanned each week leading to over reliance on our veterans and stretching the youth players. But again, a core group stayed tough, shared the load with double headers and sharing game time. You certainly get value for money for your fees with the Reds! We were lucky to have 2 very serviceable players Jesse and Hayden out of Berri join us. The guys really gelled quickly with the group; I do hope to see you both next season.

D1 with no import and a new player coach our pitching depth was limited, and we just struggled to score runs. Regardless I think Zane did a remarkable job taking on this leadership role. It was important to develop and motivate the younger players as he did and to hold the respect of his mates he's played alongside. Zane poured his big heart into the role and learnt a lot along the way.

D3 lead by Willie were highly competitive with half the team backing up each week for D2. There was debate over team selection and club priorities each. Willie and D3 you battled hard but I think circumstance let you down unfortunately.

The lower D6/7 teams enjoyed their ball with completely the opposite success from each other. HT and D6 what a great bunch; first timers, young guys and highly functional veterans. Although you didn't come away with a win the comradery you built lies at the heart of what ball clubs are about. Equally the D7 guys with the addition of a several high-profile recruits gave D7 Red a good shake again making finals.

Realistically though we find ourselves at the crossroads. We have exhausted our youth numbers progressing into senior divisions for the next 3-5 years. To be successful on field we will rely entirely on recruitment. To attract coaches and players we must show the habits of the past I are finally behind us. With CV-19 we no longer can be sure of overseas imports and instead need to look to local and country areas. We must and will invest in the use of technology that will assist bring skill levels to the current standards that we simply do not meet right now. We need the players to engage in this. If players chose to leave or step back perhaps you can't blame them. But I want to be

realistic and have people realise next season we will need every baseballer to stand by us or potentially we will be at risk of losing the privilege of being a Division 1 club.

By setting a bar higher to upskill on field, having the right people to implement training program and players be receptive to better physical and mental regimes. I believe this is the direction to create a firm foundation for success. This is a long-term view and not a quick fix, but we have been in this cycle far too long.

It is unknown how BSA structures will be adjusted next season. There is talk of a return to Saturday Senior baseball and who knows if the u17/ D3 switch will remain. But this does have us at Northern Districts needing to finally stop with the excuses, stop pointing out just the failures, working against each other behind the scenes, and focus on working as a club on actually improving and promoting some of the many positive things we do achieve. We should be striving to be better not only as a club but as individuals. As a committee we are required to do a better job of leading and promoting the positive. Our Senior teams need to be highly competitive and we need to have a strong junior program. I hope we can continue to add move enthusiastic people to achieve more to administer the club to this success on field and fine tune what is a really great family club off field.

In closing thank you to all those that assisted umpiring games this season. As BUASA (SA Umpires Association) continue to struggle to recruit umpires' clubs have no choice but to contribute. We are well short on options with experience and implementing a roster did assist to share the load. We need more people to do the simple online course and attend an education session. It is likely to be mandatory to have basic accreditation next season or you will not be able to umpire. This could result in the home club being handed a forfeit, a situation we all want to avoid because we had too few accredited and willing to volunteer. Please give yourself a chance and do the training as it will benefit everyone.

In closing there is still lots to be proud of as a club. As frustrating and challenging at times there are many great moments that make me proud to be involved. I am excited by the opportunity and look forward to bigger and better things next season.

The board of Management submits the Financial Accounts of the Association for the year ended April 30th 2021.


In accordance with the Associations Incorporations Act. 1985 (as amended) we report as follows:

## NOTES TO THE ACCOUNT FOR YEAR ENDED 30 APRIL 2020

To suit the Summer Baseball Season, the decision was made at the 2018 AGM to move the club's financial year to end 30th April. To give better financial visibility, 2019's report was completed up until 31st March 2019.

Sales category refers to sale of Automatic Coffee Machine & Club Vehicle

Due to COVID, Salisbury Council waived Council Fees from April to December 2020.

Extra costs spent in General Expenses/Cleaning due to hire of West Beach training facilities for Pre Season and extra club room cleaning due to COVID virus through 2020.

Whilst International Imports were not used this season (also due to COVID), cost shown for Imports represents monies paid for 2 players travel expenses from Riverland each week.

### INTANGIBLE ASSETS

### Division 2:

It was a tough year not being able to have a consistent team. I feel this team did not reach their full potential, most of the chances we had at taking the wins would just be out of hands reach with this generally being to one inning stricken with errors. But we cleaned that up towards the end of the season. Unfortunately, early on in the season we lost our key starting pitch Jesse Stemberger to an on going arm injury. ### Division 1:

Unfortunately, it wasn't our best year, again I don't think we reached our full potential. Losing 4 division 1 starters is hard on any team in the league let alone us who struggle for numbers. That been said it was huge opportunity for some of our younger players to step up and show us what they got. We had Kelahn Broome sit bench all year for us finally coming on in the last game although he did not get to have an at bat, he took a great catch in right field. Tom O'Meara found himself starting a twilight game when we were short on players, going 1-3 and making a great pick at first base while being trampled and holding onto the ball. Cameron did not miss one training this year he puts in the effort outside of trainings to make himself a better ball player as a pitcher you know if you have 2 strikes on a batter you can bury the next pitch and Cameron will block it. Countless times you will see Cameron diving in the other batter's box just to knock down a fastball one of our pitchers have thrown 3 feet short of the plate and keeping it in front. Cameron's batting average does not justify his approach in the box Cameron puts himself in good counts and always puts a good swing on the ball. Great things are to come from you two guys.

One thing we lack as a team is self-confidence, we don't believe we have earned our spot as a team we need to believe in our capabilities and show that we do deserve to be there. We need to do the little things listen to all our coaches, put in the hard work at training and most of all do it as a team and have fun I look forward to playing the next few seasons with this group I love each and every one of you guys.

As the season continued, there were moments that showed that the trainings and teachings were having an effect as Division 6 came within a few runs of Woodville, Adelaide and even limited eventual premiers East Torrens to 9 runs (made even more impressive as East Torrens considered this was going to be a cakewalk and expected no less than 20 runs). Yet despite this improvement, the other teams also improved during the off-season and that all elusive win remained ever so slightly out of reach for the Reds despite their strong performance on the field.

Despite this, the team always went out and did their best. There was plenty of vocalisation and support even when the going got tough. Players developed their skills and ended the season better than they started. Ben Shinas became a wall at third base, Travis Wilton didn't strike out all season, Patrick Pile took running snow cone catches and Josh Parise commanded the centerfield. To further highlight improvements, Haydon Sanders received his call-up to the bigger league while a total of 5 players played at least 1 game for Division 3.

I couldn't be prouder of the effort that the players put in, especially the newer players who wished to better themselves. There are many who are nipping at the heels of players higher up and more than deserve a permanent call-up after their efforts this season.

I hope to see these players out again for the 2021-22 season so we can reverse the results from this year.

Thank you all for this opportunity to be part of this fun team.

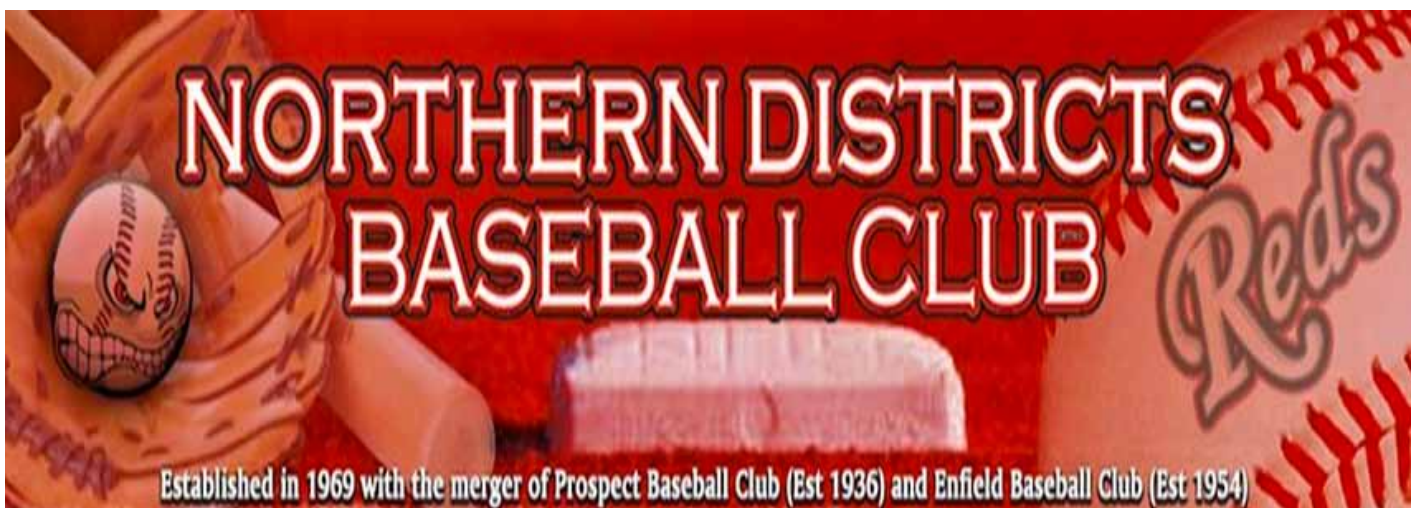

## U14 2020/2021 SEASON REPORT

This season we combined Norths with Gawler Rangers to provide the kids with an opportunity to keep playing in this age group and avoid any pause that might have seen players walk away from the game. With only one pitcher, four catchers and three players in their first year it was certainly an interesting challenge.

The season began slow, moving the kids around to try and find where they best fit on the diamond. Our first win came in game 4 against Golden Grove. Daniel not only hit the ball well but had some strong performances on the hill although at times he had trouble finding the strike zone. I'm sure he will look forward to going back to catching next season but I hope he enjoyed the season as our starting pitcher. Other pitchers this year were Austin, Amelia (Milley) and Cooper. Austin was similar to Daniel, could throw hard but would struggle to find the strike zone. His best performance was against Glenelg. Footnote - The season began with two coaches and we lost Dene after only 4 weeks, this did not help with the development of the kids, it is crucial for the kids to have someone who can provide that one on one coaching to ensure pitching and catching development continues to allow the kids to reach their full potential as there is a lot to learn at the U14/15 age bracket. If we run this age group again next season, combined clubs or single club, it will be a must to have two coaches with the appropriate skills to be able to deliver a training approach that covers the basics of the game as well the finer skills of baseball that a second coach can provide.

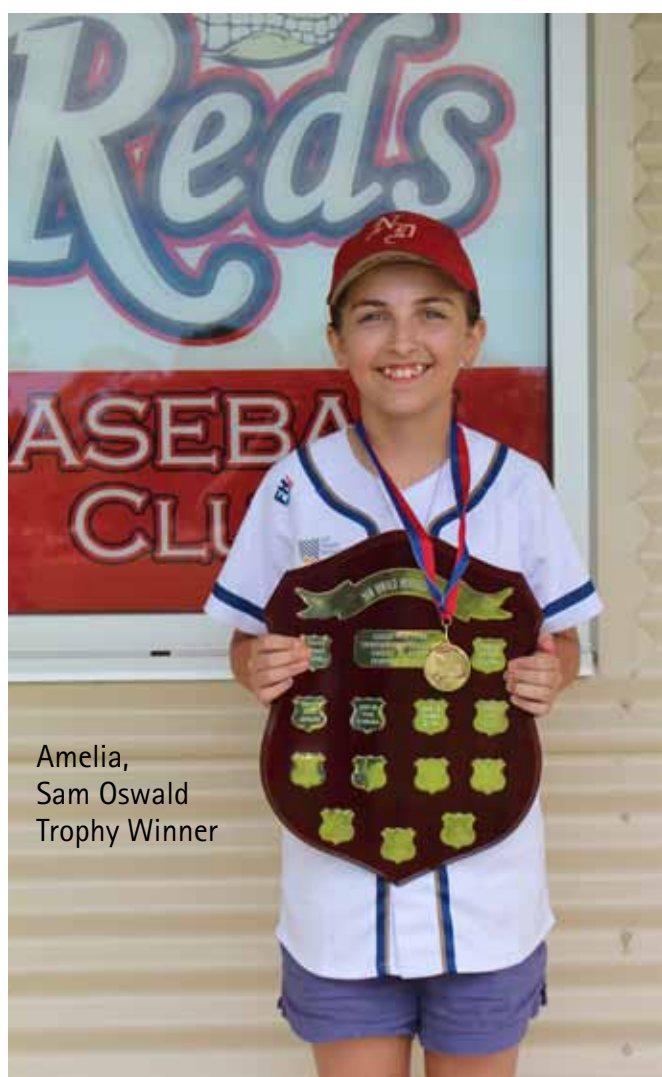
