GROWING OUR CLUB

Juniors

- Introduce a 'Batter Up' program during the 2023 "off season"
- Introduce a T-Ball team by the start of the of the 2023/24 season
- Introduce an Under 12's team by the start of the 2024/25 season
- Introduce an Under 16's team by the start of the 2025/26 season
- Introduce an Under 18's team by the start of the 2026/27 season

Seniors

- Grow the number of players from 26 adult players in 2023 to 50 registered players for the 2024/2025 season including at least 10 players who qualify for the Masters team
- Ensure our over 35's team compete in at least two tournaments per year
- By 2024/25 have two masters teams competing in at least one tournament per year

OUR COACHES AND UMPIRES

Coaches

- Recruit and develop coaches so that every team has a coach by the 2023/24 season
- Fund all coaches to participate in at least the Softball Victoria Foundation Level coaching course each year

Officials

- Recruit at least one umpire and scorer per team by the start of each season
- Fund all umpires to participate in at least the Softball Victoria Foundation Level umpiring course each year
- Fund all scorers to participate in at least the Softball Victoria Foundation Level scoring course each year



OUR GOALS & OBJECTIVES

FUNDRAISING AND SPONSORSHIP

Increase our club sponsorship to \$5,000 (or more) per year for the next three years to support the club operations and the achievement of our strategic goals including:

- At least \$2,500 of sponsorship in the 2023/24 season
- Hold at least 3 whole club fundraisers each season and have full participation from all members
