



Code of Conduct

The Port Macquarie Rowing Club seeks to provide a safe and congenial environment for all its members and expects that members will conform to expected behaviour standards, both on and off the water. Failure to do so may result in the Committee taking such action as is deemed appropriate by the circumstances, which may include a member being asked to leave the Club. Members shall:

- Not act in a manner unbecoming or contrary to the interests of the Club.
- Treat fellow members with courtesy, respect, and proper regard for their rights and obligations.
- Treat property of the Club and its members with due respect.
- Not misuse funds or Club property, or the property, or the private property of Club members.
- Uphold and not injure the standing and reputation of the Club and the sport of rowing.
- Not engage in "sledging" (abuse or ridiculing) of other competitors, officials or regatta organisers.
- Not engage in inappropriate sexual relations with junior Club members (see Child Protection Policy).
- Assist other Club members as necessary, and promote safe practices, both on and off the water.
- Obey directives of the Club Captain (or delegates) with regard to the use of Club equipment.
- Not use banned substances (as outlined in Rowing Australia's Doping Policy).
