Role of Spotters



The responsibility of the Race Spotters during each race is as follows:

1. Supervise your designated pilot
2. Notify Pilot if they miss an obstacle and need to re-attempt
 - a. Most pilots will do this automatically, but you may need to remind some. If they ignore you and keep going, ask them again. Failure to react and redo the missed obstacle will result in the pilot being DQ and asked to land immediately.
3. Notify the Pilot if they fly out of bounds (Pilot will be DQ and asked to land immediately)
4. Call out the Pilots name and Lap number each time they complete a lap (Pass through the start gate)
5. Once the race is complete, confer with Race Director to determine winner
