Winter Competition Rules update

Grading meeting update

As requested by Nathan to review the following:

- Transparency regarding grading (i.e. an expectation that a club lists a minimum of 11 players in their top grade).

In relation to above -All guidelines were followed in team list and grading process. These guidelines/ rules are sent out with nominations and selection date info

- Expectation regarding the grading of 4 minimum All clubs should name the required minimum of 4 players (highlighted in yellow) in preparation for the season (within comp rules already)
 In relation to this- evidenced that the copy provided on the day (by MV) was printed version of an incorrect and earlier draft copy, in black and white hence highlights not captured. At grading meeting, all Clubs and delegates had access to full completed lists with team gradings
- To reduce the 'shuffling' that goes on upon season commencement; an expectation that players who were not initially named are placed either in First Grade until the second grading meeting; or in the grade with the least number of players listed.

In relation to above, Winter Comp rules don't accommodate this and should have eleven 11 players named

- Further discussion in relation to grading age and what should the cut off age be. This may need to be considered in future but not at present
- Noted that grading day had more than required number of grading selectors present and represented all Clubs
