General Business

Umpiring

Paul raised concerns with the lack of support that had been given to developing umpires for the 7's, 9's & 11's competition especially when they are paying \$22 umpire levies. Discussions then took place on the lack of development for umpires including classes and mentoring of Juniors which was outlined by the Umpire Coordinator at the meeting at season start.

It was agreed that an email will be sent to Clubs asking them for assistance with supervising and training junior umpires for the 7's, 9's & 11's.

Concerns were also raised on the allocation of umpires to the draw with instances of Clubs providing both umpires for matches while also playing, and while it was understood there were few people in the pool there didn't appear to be any follow up to boost the pool with members who had umpired in the past. There are a few umpires doing a lot of matches and burn out is a concern.

The most pressing challenge for the competition is development of more umpires or encouragement of members who previously umpired returning to alleviate the pressure on the ones now allocated.

The meeting moved to closed discussions to address performance issues with the Umpire Coordinator position.

Player Behaviour/Abuse

Alicia raised the issue of player abuse towards umpires and cited an incident recently where a junior umpire on a senior match was brought to tears by abuse from a player. Several of the Executive had also witnessed or heard of the incident. It was agreed that junior umpires need to be protected and the reason for having senior mentors is for them to step in and support the junior umpire and act on unacceptable behaviour whether or not the senior umpire has seen or heard the incident themselves. Paul also cited a similar incident.

The Committee agreed on a course of action as follows-

- A reminder be sent to all members that unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated. This includes dissent or abuse of umpires and that if poor behaviour results in the loss of an umpire the player responsible would be called to umpire themselves.
- That a direction be given to junior umpires who are being mentored in either the Junior or Senior competitions that if they are subjected to any form of backchat or abuse, they immediately stop the match and report it to the senior mentoring umpire.

The senior umpire will act on the junior umpire's report and penalise the player as if they themselves had been subjected to the behaviour themselves.

All umpires be sent a direction to not tolerate any unacceptable behaviour from players
especially backchat or dissent and penalise players with cards. They are also to report any
concerns they have with players to the Coordinator for referral to the Executive who will
request the Club to counsel these members.

While the Executive Committee can't cite for on-field incidents they can direct Clubs to address reports of unacceptable behaviour with their members.

F45 Gym Sponsorship

Glenn advised that the proprietor of F45 in Bowral had given an open invitation for either Club or rep teams to experience a free program with them. Glenn will forward particulars for distribution to Clubs.

Open Mens Rep Team Selection

Cat raised concerns from Moss Vale Club that no trials were scheduled for selection of the Open Mens team although they had 17-18 nominations. Two players are listed as shadow players who had no opportunity to try out and a couple of players were selected who don't play in the local competition.

It was noted that the Representative Team Selection Guidelines were not followed in this instance and that would be addressed for future selection of all teams.

Next meeting will be on Wednesday 28th June 6.00pm at Alexandra Room Mittagong RSL Club.

There being no further business the meeting closed at 7.45pm.

The Committee will be issuing invoices to Clubs for their 2023 turf and training fees this week. A copy of the schedule accompanying the invoices follows.

Work continues with the Office of Sport to finalise the grant for the Field 1 mat replacement and determine the contribution that is to be made to that project which should be around \$49,000 due to the shock pad not needing to be replaced.

Council completed their annual compliance audit 2 weeks ago and an email issued to Clubs on the correct storage of the junior goals as 2 were unlocked and stored around the wrong way. An email has been forwarded to Clubs with photos on the correct storage arrangements.

All the exterior lights and sensors have been replaced over recent weeks to improve security and the fence near the playground is being repaired this week after it being cut sometime earlier in the month.
