## What do you need to utilise this system?


- a) A device eg iPad, Computer, Smartphone
- b) Access to the internet
- c) Mozilla Firefox engine – Downloadable free from

- d) To enter data / score you will need to be an authorised administrator
- e) To do this register with the site by following the steps below

## 2. Registering on the site

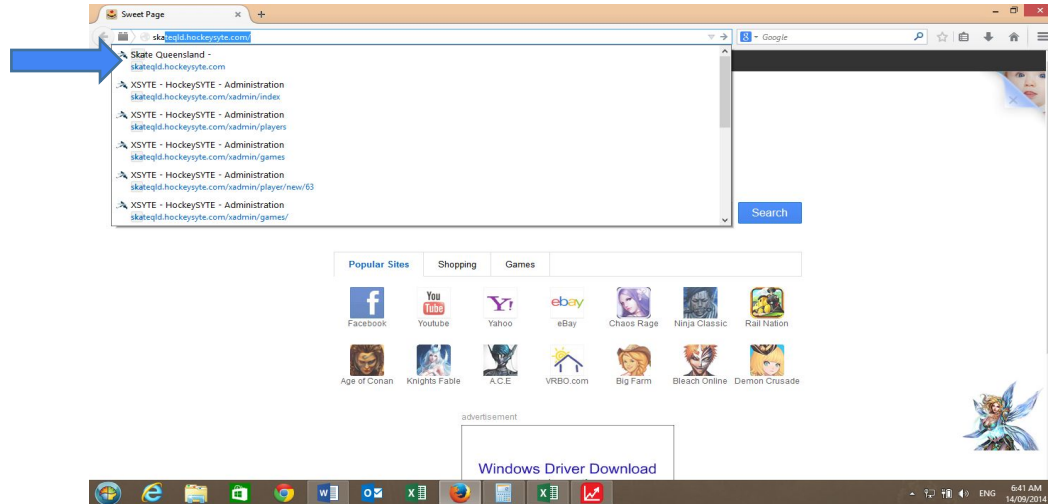







Once FIREFOX is open in the address bar start to type in Skate Queensland or whatever site you are currently logging in to.

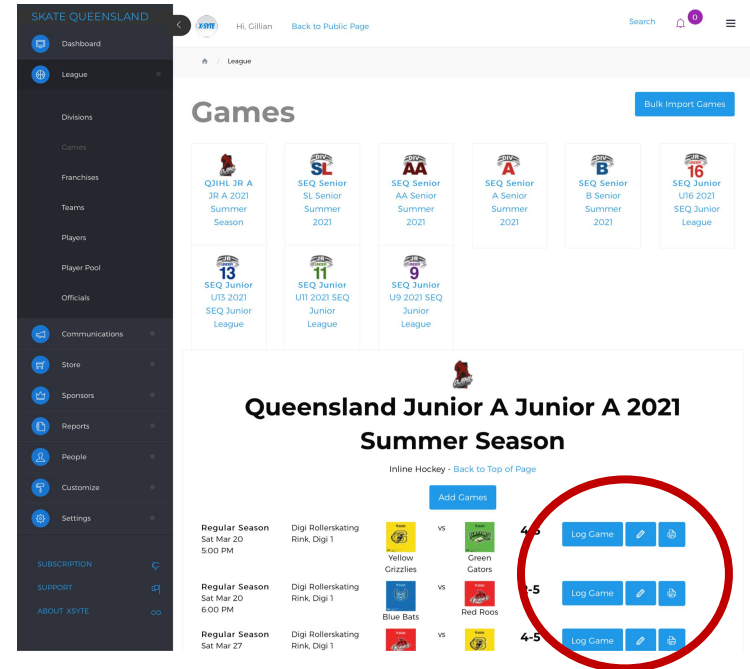
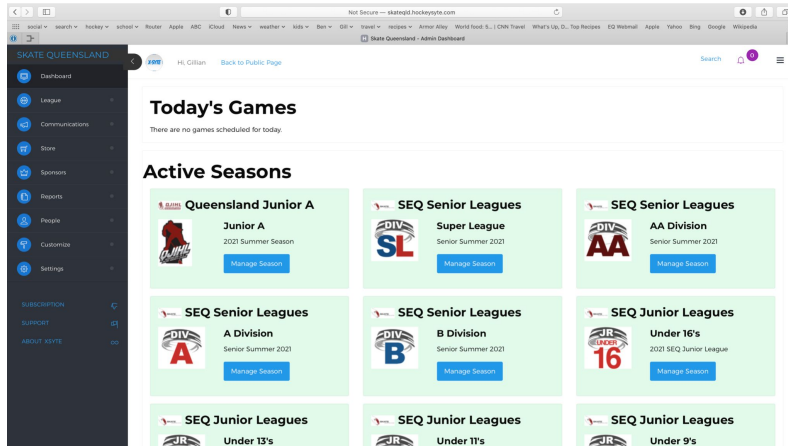

# 4. Scoring a Game

Once logged in as an Admin, the games for the day will appear in the dashboard - Click “Log Game” next to the game you wish to score





Click on “Rosters” tab

Click the check boxes next to the players who are playing

Make sure ‘roster updated’ appears before making any further selections

Once roster has been finished click on “Gamesheet” tab

You can go back and forwards between tabs anytime just keep an eye on the top to ensure the computer has finished

Click on “Add shot on Goal” for shots on Goal. **It is the team shooting that receives the shot on goal**

For a goal click on “Add Goal”

Type in the Time, Goal and Assists and what type of Goal it was (ie Power Play)

Click on “Submit Goal”

From the Gamesheet tab:

For a penalty Click on “Add Penalty”

In the scroll down box select the player. If the player does not appear on the list go back to roster and relick that player. If for some reason this still does not work click your page refresh untick and tick the player again.

If you start typing in the penalty a drop down box will appear and you can highlight the correct penalty. Ensure the duration of the penalty is correct. If anything other than a minor you will need to type in the minutes. Once puck drops type in the clock time. (ie 20.11)

Click on "Divisions"


Click on "Create a New Season"

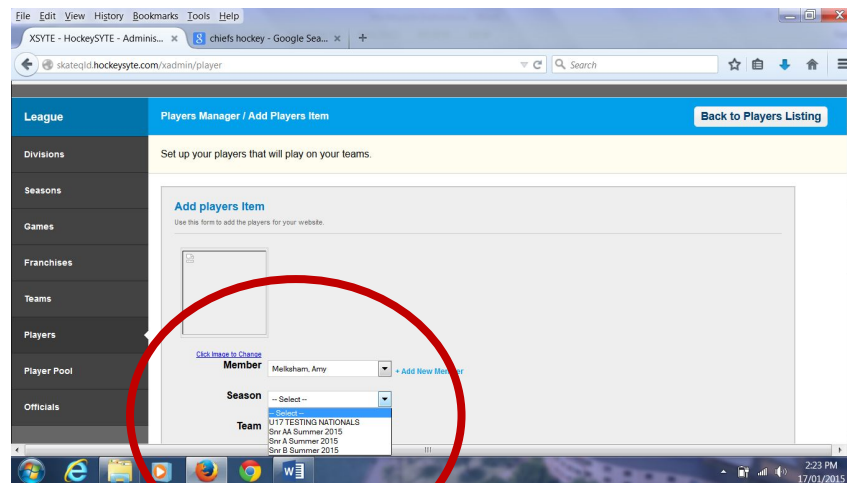
