	Mast is securely fastened to the hull. (either tied or Class mast-clamp)
	At least 1 bailer, min capacity of 1 litre, is securely tied to the hull.
	One paddle, securely tied to the hull.
	Buoyancy tanks (3) in good condition and maintain inflation.
	The centreboard must be securely attached to the hull.
	Two toe straps & must be securely attached to the hull.
	The Strop on the boom must be tightened, so that the gap between the boom and the strop is no more than 10 cm.
	The rudder is securely attached to the hull.
	Class approved clip on mainsheet / strop.
	Red Protest flag.
