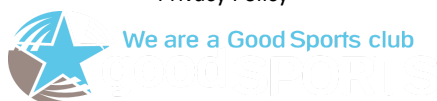

WSA TEAM FEE PAYMENTS

All payments are made through RevSport by the individual player on registration.

Players are required to be registered in their main grade. Here are some examples for those playing in multiple grades -

- A player plays both Open 3 & 4 full time they register in Open 4
- A player plays Open 3 full time and plays less than 5 games for Open 2 then they would register in Open 3
- A player plays both Open 2 & 3 full time they register in Open 2
- A player plays both Open 1 & 2 full time they register in Open 2

***Please note these examples are for registration purposes only - all players will need to be added into the correct team lists.**

SOFTBALL VICTORIA / SOFTBALL AUSTRALIA REGISTRATION

Softball Victoria uses Revolutionise Sport as the participant registration program.

ALL players and officials **MUST** be registered in RevSport and allocated to the team PRIOR to participation in the game.

SV registration is paid directly through the RevSport system when registering.

CLUB UMPIRING REQUIREMENTS

ALL CLUBS – UMPIRE COORDINATOR

- Each WSA Club MUST supply a Club Coordinator - the details of this person must be emailed to wuc.operations@gmail.com prior to the season commencing.
- This person will be the umpire contact point and liaison for each individual club.
- If a club fails to nominate an Umpire Coordinator this will default to the President of the club until otherwise advised.

OPEN (ALL GRADES), U18 AND U16:

- WSA will provide accredited umpires for all Open, U18 and U15 games, where possible.
- Clubs are required to provide one umpire for every team they enter in the season competition.
- Clubs are required to assist with at least one umpire per team on days affected by Championship competition.

U12 MIXED

- Clubs must supply **ONE umpire for ALL GAMES FOR THE WHOLE SEASON** – *SEMR requires an umpire travel with the team to umpire each week.*
- Clubs should roster appropriately experienced umpires depending on the standard of the grade.

SATURDAYS:

- Umpires must report to the umpires' room at least 25 minutes prior to start of the nominated game time to sign in and receive the match card or diamond allocations.
- If a club fails to supply an umpire the Club Umpire Policy - Section 24 of the WSA Operations Manual will apply.

NIGHT GAMES:

- WSA will provide Softball Australia Accredited umpires for all Open night games where possible.
- The team allocated to the 3rd base bench is responsible for turning on and off the lights, packing up and raking the diamond and locking the toilets.
- If a non WSA team is listed as 3rd base bench, then the WSA team is responsible for locking up.

FINALS:

- Clubs participating in finals may be required to provide umpires during the finals series for each team playing. Time slots may vary in order to provide neutral umpires.

EQUIPMENT: as per the WBSC Fastpitch 2022-2025 Rule Book

- All umpires must wear covered shoes.
- Junior umpires (under 18 years) must wear full protective equipment when umpiring any grade.
- Senior umpires must wear (at least) a mask and chest protector when umpiring any grade.
- Junior umpires (under 18 years) must wear a hat or cap. All adult umpires are encouraged to wear a hat.

** For a double header there is to be a minimum of 20 minutes interval between the 4pm and 6pm games. The finish time for the second game will be 2 hours after the commencement time.*

AGE GROUPS

All junior grades are defined by age groups: U13, U16 and U18.

Age is defined as 1 October in the current season for U13s and U16s.

Age is defined as 1 October in the current season for U18.

ELIGIBILITY**GENERAL ELIGIBILITY**

To be read in conjunction with the WSA Operations Manual

- The minimum age for a player playing in an open senior competition shall be 14 years of age as of 31 December of the current season. Clubs must submit a dispensation request for any player under the age of 14 who wishes to play in an open senior competition by completing both the Player Assessment Form and requesting a dispensation through RevSport.
- Clubs must submit a dispensation request for junior players who wish to pitch in Open 4 or lower, and who also pitch in age u/16 and above State Championship teams, Representative teams, or above.

- Clubs must submit a dispensation request for any player who wishes to play Open 2 or lower, and who has represented at an International/National Open Women's Tournament or been in an Open State Team or Squad (excl. O35 Teams) in the past 2 years. Dispensation request details must include positions held within the above-mentioned team/s. ***This applies unless the player is under 18 years of age as at December 31 in the current season.***

All dispensations will be considered and determined by the WSA Match Committee. The WSA Match Committee has the authority to consult with the WSA Committee if deemed necessary.

Any player who has been given dispensation to play must play under any stipulations provided by the WSA Match Committee. If a player is found to be playing outside of these stipulations, they will be classified as an ineligible player and the ineligible player penalty will apply.

Notwithstanding the above, the WSA Match Committee can, at any time, determine that a player is playing in a grade not appropriate to their skill level, irrespective of their age.

FINALS ELIGIBILITY

A player must have played at least seven (7) games to be eligible for finals for that ***team***. For example, if a player has played 4 O1 games and 7 O2 games and 7 O3 games, they are eligible for finals in both O2 and O3 but not in O1.

Clubs may request permission in writing to wsamatchcommittee@gmail.com to vary the eligibility rules for players who register after the Christmas break. These requests will be considered by the WSA Match Committee.

MATCH COMMITTEE

In the 2023-2024 season the match committee will be responsible for the safe conduct of matches, player eligibility, dispensation, complaints reports and fixtures. All requests to the **Match Committee** should be directed via email to wsamatchcommittee@gmail.com or put through RevSport if a dispensation request.

FEEDBACK AND COMPLAINT PROCEDURE

ALL complaints and reports made against players, officials or umpires MUST follow the procedure as per the Waverley Operations Manual which can be found online or in the WSA Control Room.

FORMAL PROTESTS

In the event of a protest occurring, it is preferable that a) 1 senior umpire of SAL Accreditation level 3 or above or b) at least two umpires of SAL Accreditation level 2 be responsible for hearing the protest at the time it is lodged.

If no senior umpires are available to hear the protest immediately, a written protest must then be lodged. The game is to be played out to regulation and the scorecard handed in UNSIGNED. For the full procedure please refer to the Waverley Operations Manual.

ALL TEAM ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED BY 20 SEPTEMBER 2023

YOU MUST SUBMIT ONE FORM PER TEAM

An umpire must be nominated for each team entered (except U12).

All umpire nominations will be reviewed by the UIC.

The club may apply to the Umpire in Chief (UIC) for approval for alternative provision for umpiring responsibilities (e.g., the club umpiring allocation could be shared by several players not just one, or the umpire provided may be available for a different time slot to that grade's games). All competition allocations will be managed by the UIC.

Waverley will not accept team entries as final until any umpire nominated has been approved by the UIC.

TEAM LISTS

All team lists must be completed via REVSPORT. Each club must add players into the teams in which they will participate.

If a player is not allocated into a team prior to participating, they will be deemed as ineligible.

You are also required to allocate officials per team in RevSport. This does not limit them to only participating with this team however it shows the official is registered.

All Team Lists can be reviewed at Match Committee discretion.

SOFTBALL VICTORIA PERMITS AND CLEARANCES REGULATIONS

These Regulations are made under the Softball Victoria Board's Regulation making power in the Rules and contain various directions and requirements of the Association which are, where the context so indicates, mandatory, but which are not of a general nature which justifies inclusion in the main body of the Rules.

ALL PERMITS AND CLEARANCES MUST BE COMPLETED THROUGH REVSPORT

WAVERLEY PERMITS AND CLEARANCES REGULATIONS

- Internal WSA – player/coach/umpire/official must have permits **submitted** in RevSport prior to their 1st game or they will be deemed ineligible.
- External Permits - player/coach/umpire/official must have permits **submitted** in RevSport prior to their 1st game or they will be deemed ineligible.
- All players/coaches/umpires/officials can only be registered with one home club during a season.
