

WYC Code of Conduct

Wynyard Yacht Club Inc endorses the following Code of Conduct for its members. We expect that as a member, you will observe the following during any Club activity, presence on site or social media discussion:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others;
- Be fair, equitable, considerate and honest in your dealings with others;
- Acknowledge the principals of diversity and inclusion;
- Be professional and take responsibility for your actions;
- Use club facilities and equipment for their proper purpose and correctly care for and maintain them while reporting damage;
- Acknowledge that many do work for the club do so in a voluntary capacity and deserve to be treated respectfully;
- Preserve and protect the standing and reputation of the Club;
- Refrain from doing anything which may reasonably be considered abuse, intimidation, or harassment of others.

As a member, you are responsible for your conduct of your guests whilst at the Club.

Breaches of this code of Conduct may result in a complaint to the Management Committee.
